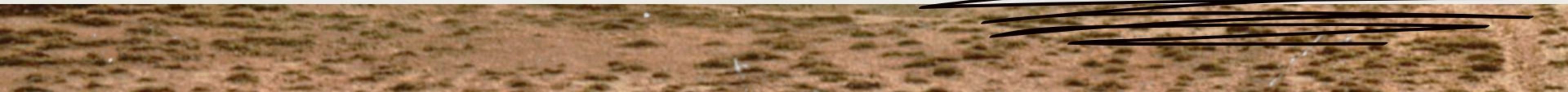


LIVING from wholeness
